The market features citrus, stonefruit, apples, vegetables, farmed Murray Cod indigenous to Murray River waterways, olives and olive oil, nuts, prime beef and lamb, veal, eggs, wines, honey, cheeses, cut native flowers and lavender products. Chutney's, jams, breads, homemade cakes and organic herbal teas are some of the products that tempt the foodie tastebuds. For the home gardener, bagged manure and hay come straight from the farm, plus find vegetable and herb seedlings and succulents. The rich diversity of farm produce at this farmers market entices anyone interested in food or foodie products. It is also a great way to meet and chat with regional producers. The Yarrawonga Farmers' Market is a true farmers market so all products available are subject to seasonal availability. So if it's not there it's not in season in the area.
